The Phillip Island Road support work begins!

The San Remo Foreshore Committee of Management (SRFCoM) is delighted to see the work on this vital \$2M project well under way. During the works, traffic lights will control the entry and exiting of trucks, with the speed limit reduced to 40km/ph between Keam Street and Panorama Drive in San Remo.

“Understandably there will be some short-term impacts on traffic along Phillip Island Road” said Andy Chappell, Chair of the SRFCoM. “Public access to sections of the foreshore will also be effected, but the removal of some vegetation is necessary to ensure the long term stability of the foreshore and the everyone’s safety. The committee is closely involved during the project to ensure protection of the foreshore and the continuation of the walking track along this northerly fringe of Western Port Bay. We will soon be announcing plans for a large tree planting program at this site, guided by local volunteer experts and will be looking for community ‘hands and feet’ support. Our present estimate is that we will be planting some 7000 trees and shrubs at the site later this year!”
